## **The subject of Martyrdom and the image of a Martyr in the works of Ibrahim Yusifoglu**

Ibrahim Yusifoglu, like his predecessors, showed bravery in his work to ensure the sovereignty and territorial integrity of his homeland, he was able to reflect the perfect image of the people who fought for the homeland and gave their lives for high deeds, professions, convictions, and their martyrdom.
