The terrorist policy of the terrorist state

During the last month, the victorious Azerbaijani army has been liberating the occupied territories of our country. The armed "forces" of Armenia are retreating after losing the battles with the Azerbaijani army. The enemy, who did not resist on the battlefield, continues its ugly and dishonorable terrorist policy by targeting the civilian population of Azerbaijan with the aim of breaking the will of our nation and our state, as in the 90s, almost from the first days of the Second Karabakh War. Unwilling to come to terms with its defeat, the Armenian state is targeting civilians living in Tartar, Migechevir, Ganja, Barda and other Azerbaijani towns and villages who are far from the battle line and who did not participate in military operations. In most cases, the firing by means of ballistic missiles is carried out from the territory of Armenia, and the other purpose is provocation.

By targeting the cities and villages of Azerbaijan, the Armenian authorities provoke Azerbaijan to target its territory. The purpose of such provocations is to involve the countries of the Collective Security Treaty Organization, of which Armenia is a member, and primarily Russia, into the conflict. Such dirty deeds have been and continue to be a part of Armenia's policy at the state level. Regarding the use of ballistic missiles against the civilian population, it should be noted that all international conventions prohibit such actions. States and individuals who practice this must be held accountable before the International Military Tribunal. It should be noted that the fall of ballistic missiles launched from the territory of Armenia on the cities and villages of Azerbaijan cannot be called a coincidence. Because during the use of missile weapons, that is, Tochka-U, R-17 SKAD type operational tactical missile systems, the digital coordinates of the target are entered and a combat task is assigned to them

Let's hope that this activity of Armenia will be prevented by international organizations soon and the persons directly involved in terrorist activities will be brought to justice.
